Course Description:

Kantha is a meditative rhythmic technique enabling the mind to rest whilst using simple stitches on linen. During this relaxing wellness session you can choose to stitch either a Hare or Tree of Life design and create a beautiful lavender bag. At the end of the session, you will be familiar with basic Kantha techniques and stitches and leave rested with a hand-stitched design for a lavender bag.

All levels of stitchers are welcome, and the kit comes with everything you need to finish this lavender bag
